





#### **Family Room Safety**

Home Is Where We feel Safe

Our church home is Our Divine Savior parish. Father Francis wants to assure members of our family that we take the safety of our members very seriously. With the recent Tehama County shootings, we are a bit unnerved and want to do all we can to keep our gatherings safe. Bishop Soto has been conferencing with our priests about how to assist those who were traumatized by the shootings, and he is encouraging each parish to put into place procedures to enhance our safety.

What is ODS doing? Last year, even before the recent trauma, Father Francis and Dan Layne went over the whole parish looking especially for areas where our safety needed to be upgraded. New locks and keys were installed. There is an increased emphasis on locking the doors and reminding key holders they are accountable for safety. Bushes were trimmed for better visibility. Security cameras are in place. Dan arrives early each day to patrol the grounds and be sure there are no unauthorized people on the property.

We are not being alarmist when we ask for the help of every parishioner. The best thing you can do is to stay alert any time you are on church property (or anywhere else). The greeters and ushers are charged with keeping a watchful eye out for anyone who seems disturbed or in need of assistance. If you see or hear something of concern, speak up! We can get to know the people with whom we worship and reach out to welcome those we don't yet know.

In the final analysis, our security comes from our God, who loves each one of us dearly. He desires us to live in faith, hope, and love—not in fear. We can rely on the presence of Jesus with us whenever we gather. We should continue to pray for his protection for our family and for healing for those who would harm us.




