

Job description – Project Manager

This is not a largely desk-based job; the position involves active project implementation. There is a requirement to control and manage a portfolio of multiple projects simultaneously and a duty to report on progress through Cruden's administrative system to the operations manager.

The ideal candidate will be motivated, flexible and extremely pragmatic. The role will not suit those with a preference for a "9 to 5" job. The candidate must be willing to travel globally and work autonomously as well as in a team. A passion for cars or motorsport is an advantage.
