The Hall develops both the artist and the audience. The Hall showcases and protects Newfoundland and Labrador culture with 245 nights of programming each and every year!

THE KANGIDLUASUK STUDENT PROGRAM AT THE TORNGAT MOUNTAINS BASE CAMP IN LABRADOR

The kANGIDLUASUk Student program provides experiential work and learning opportunities for Inuit youth from Nunatsiavut, Nunavik, and across Canada at an Inuit base camp in the Torngat Mountains. The kANGIDLUASUk Student Program is designed to bring Inuit youth together to share learnings and help them become leadership ambassadors in their communities.

Through a multi-faceted and crosscultural internship integrating Inuit culture, arctic science, and outdoor adventure, kANGIDLUASUk students:

- Live, learn and work together with some of Canada's top Arctic researchers, Parks Canada staff, local Inuit leaders and elders.
- Experience traditional Inuit practices, values and customs.
- Explore the Torngat Mountains as an Inuit homeland.
- Acquire practical work experience and build respect, self-confidence and other leadership skills.

- Support each other while discovering areas of personal interest, skill, and capacity.
- Engage in environmental stewardship initiatives in Torngat Mountains National Park.
- Experience healthy living—drug and alcohol free.
- Find inspiration and share reflections through music, art, writing, and storytelling.
