- Develop and maintain a safe, harmonious social environment for the students.
- Provide regular communication to Class Teacher about curriculum, student performance and unusual incidents.
- Begin and end classes on time to support Class Teachers' daily schedule.
- Participation in recess coverage for grades 1 – 8.
