

## Champagne

•**Tribaut Brut Tradition 595**

Fruity and floral notes on the nose. Very fresh and lively. fine and delicate on the palate, with hints of dried fruit and apricot flavours.

•**Tribaut Brut Rosé 595**

A fruity and elegant Champagne, dominated with red fruit flavours such as blackcurrant and raspberry. Nice mature complexity on the palate along with a superb light salmon colour.

## Cap Classique

•**Colmant Brut Chardonnay 349**

Delicate light gold colour with a lime-green hue. The nose starts with fresh lemony, floral and green apple notes

followed by yeasty and biscuity aromas brought by the lengthy maturation on the lees.

•**Graham Beck Brut or Brut Rosé 289**

The Brut yields a consistent flavour of fresh granny smith apples with overtones of freshly baked biscuits rounded by a creamy yet fresh mouth feel. Rosé, explosive mousse, intensely savoury and generous finish.

•**Nitida Matriarch in Red (Shiraz) 249**

Meaty shiraz, entwines harmoniously with basil and wild watercress. Strains of vanilla, cloves and pink peppercorns.

Crisp, stimulating and rewarding on the palate. The only way to start an evening or luncheon.

•**Simonsig Kaapse Vonkel Brut 249**

Lovely floral aromas, mouth-watering berry flavours of red grapes and a touch of Chardonnay citrus freshness with unmistakable flavours of freshly-baked bread and buttered toast.

A delicate balance exists between the crisp acidity and subtle creaminess on the palate. The fine effervescence delights the taste buds and brings the bouquet to the forefront once again.

## Sauvignon Blanc

•**Bouchard Finlayson 229**

This wine has a strong vibrant aroma, tropical fruits of pineapple, litchi and granadilla. This is followed by a firm

crisp palate signalling a determined structure with parallel fruit calling one straight back to the glass!

Shows a complex array of tropical fruit, grapefruit and limes all held together by an incredible mineral backbone. The palate is rich and full, made in a style to be a wonderful food companion.

Flavours of passionfruit and ripe mangoes with a long, clean mineral and zesty citrus finish.

•**Delaire Graff Coastal Cuvée 219**

Rich in tropical fruit flavours. These are underpinned by layers of blackcurrant, gooseberry and nettle. Well-balanced and complex it finishes long with concentrated fruit and fresh, crisp acidity.

An expression of tropical fruit on the nose – gooseberry and passionfruit, with notes of ripe figs, lemongrass and capsicum.

**Glass 49**

Aromas of citrus, green herbs, hints of asparagus and a touch of sweetness. Excellent natural acidity, a fine structure and a pleasant, clean finish.

On the nose high floral notes of honeysuckle, lemon zest and ruby grapefruit overlay Iona's distinctive herbal undertones.

•**Klein Constantia Estate 239**

This benchmark Sauvignon Blanc has cool origin aromas of green pepper and gooseberry which are rounded by passion-fruit. Succulent, with a fresh balance.

•**Boschendal (1685) 179**

This straw-coloured wine has an aroma of herbs and tropical fruit, with hints of lime and green fig.

•**Protea by Anthonij Rupert 115**

Typical Sauvignon Blanc lemon and lime zest flavours abound on the palate. Vibrant fresh acidity and some gravelly flint notes too.

**Glass 39**

Aromas of freshly cut grass, nettles and ginger. Lemongrass punctuates an already heady aromatic offering and provides focus, complexity and sophistication.

**Glass 59**

Brilliant greenish in appearance, this is a dramatic wine full of ripe red peppers and passion-fruit which will mature into mineral and flint.

A typical Thelema Sauvignon Blanc. Lovely fresh melon and grapefruit flavours, with a full, grassy palate, all in perfect balance.

## **Chardonnay (Unwooded)**

•**Diemersdal 149**

Concentrated spicy aromas with fresh fruit flavours. Elegant, rich fruit enhanced by apple and sweet melon. A delicious wine that lingers on the palate.

An unwooded Chardonnay matured on the lees, producing a fresh, lemony-flavoured wine with a yeasty nutty finish.

## **Chardonnay (wooded)**

•**Boschendal (1685) 179**

Elegant, harmonious, fresh lime notes heading gentle butterscotch/oak richness. A dry finish and complete food-friendly nature.

This full-bodied, rich Chardonnay offers a powerful citrus-marmalade and steely backbone. Classic toasty and butterscotch-like characters with mineral undertones. Good balance of oak followed with abundant fruit.

Attractive nut, smoke and orange notes. An easy-going but fresh wine with a firm and creamy texture and well-integrated supportive oak.

**Glass 55**

Fermented "sur lie" gives this wine lovely creamy tones balanced out with refreshing citrus notes. A cool vintage

showcasing this variety's elegance.

•**Joubert-Tradauw Barrel Fermented 199**

The elegant, classic, almond character carries hints of citrus, honey and caramel with a mineral earthiness.

A fine balance of ripe fruits and French oak, this Chardonnay offers hints of butterscotch, citrus and mango on the nose.

**Glass 44**

Hints of tropical fruit and a generous touch of spice. Luscious peach and guava flavours add to the fruitiness of this elegant wine.

Tangerine fruit and citrus blossom fragrances are apparent, with hints of vanilla pod and almond flakes. These characteristics follow through onto the palate. The fine, fresh acidity is natural and adds poise and focus to

•**AA Badenhorst Secateurs 149**

Aromas of stone fruit, citrus and some floral notes. Good fruit structure, voluptuous mouth feel and a long finish.

**Glass 44**

Grapefruit, melon and citrus flavours jump out of the glass. Mouth-tingling crispness with a long fruit laden finish.

•**Graham Beck The Game Reserve 139**

Full and juicy palate with layers of ripe tropical fruit complemented by a long, clean, crisp and lingering aftertaste.

•**Petit by Ken Forrester 119**

**Glass 35**

A youthful wine showing fresh ripe melon with a mellow, round, mild and honeysuckle fruit palate and a refreshingly long finish.

Pear, citrus and apple on the nose combine with oak vanillas, roasted coffee and almonds to give a complex structure.

•**Buitenverwachting Buiten Blanc 149**

This full-bodied Sauvignon Blanc based blend offers a variation of fruit characters including ripe gooseberry, green peppers, green melon and hints of tropical fruit.

•**Haute Cabrière Chardonnay/Pinot Noir 195**

**Glass 49**

Tropical fruit and citrus aromas. Pinot Noir adds a touch of "smoked ham" (of the expensive variety), while the wine

leaves on with a whimsical, light finish.

A lovely light straw colour. Complex nose, with hints of lemon and some pineapple. A medium-bodied palate with a creamy yet fresh finish.

•**Cederberg Bukettraube 169**

**Glass 44**

Exotic, delicate floral and fruit salad aromas, with a hint of honey, dried peach and ripe muscat. All natural sugar with a bracing fresh finish.

**Glass 35**

Delicate floral hints with spicy richness. The palate shows layers of soft summer fruits finishing off with a lovely tropical zestiness.

•**Paul Cluver Gewürztraminer 189**

One of the few drier style Gewürztraminers made in South Africa. Highly fragrant with litchi, rose petal and lime aromas leaping from the glass.

has a long, impressive aftertaste and soft, ripe tannins.

Medium to full-bodied with a deep red colour. A complex wine with black and red berry flavours well-integrated with the oak.

Exotic spices, hints of coffee, vanilla, chocolate and roasted bananas all complemented by the well-integrated oak.

### •Boschendal Sommelier 189

Rich, ripe and vibrant red and black currants, spice and plums. A classic example of South Africa's very own grape varietal.

### •Petit by Ken Forrester 119

#### Glass 35

Classic Pinotage aromas of spicy mulberries, plum pudding and cherries, supported by smoky bacon nuances. Juicy and accessible with soft palate and delicious fruit concentration.

### •Laibach (Top 10!) (Great Value) 239

Serious and suavely refined. The intense blackberry and purple fruit flavours are well-integrated with the cedar flavours of the French oak.

This bottling enjoys plenty of character! It is rich and polished with red and black wild berry fruit flavours. Layered with hints of gentle oak leaning light on textured fruit acid and refined tannins driven by a long mineral aftertaste.

This deep coloured, full-flavoured wine erupts with the seductively scented bouquet of violets.

#### Glass 44

An expressive nose with intense dark cherry spiced raspberry, black fruit and violet-infused perfume. Firm, structured elegant palate with purity of fruit and lifted freshness.

Dark purple in colour, almost black, with flashes of deep crimson. Alluring aromas of ripe black olive beckon from the glass, elegantly complemented by whiffs of pepper.

This shiraz-led blend is a beautifully layered, complex wine, with a full mouth-feel, integrated tannin structure and a lingering finish. A stunning complement to great food.

### •Ken Forrester The Gypsy (Great Value) 595

The character is somewhat 'wild', a little brambly with hints of nutmeg, cinnamon, dark spices. Vanilla scents and a distinct, concentrated red-fruit focus.

Hint of Grenache's earthy rusticity and Shiraz's noble spice with hints of nutmeg and salty black olive on the finish.
