Did you know that there have been scientific studies done about how yoga can improve stress? A study done at St. Elizabeth's Medical Center in Brighton, MA, found that in a study of 35 participants, 25 of them "noted a



significant decrease in stress and/or anxiety symptoms when a yoga regimen was implemented." (Alternative Medicine Review, March 2012)
