We also have shots of Campden House (7), of Norman Chapel (6) and of Broad Campden (6).

That is 442 in all rather more than the 427 predicted in November 2003.

We already have 110 (110) A4 prints of street views and properties on the extended High Street and some 75 (43) other prints. That is 185 now and a few more are needed within the predicted total of 200.

AERIAL OBLIQUE IMAGES

We had 8 good Commission Air prints from 2001 and 2002 before the project was launched. We have added 42 slides. That is 50 aerial images so far and we hope to add images of the approaches to end up with about 62 aerial views, all on discs, in the collection.
