Parking and transport options on the day

- On street parking is available at the church
- The reception venue is a three minute drive from the church. Park in the first car park on your right after you drive over the small hump bridge
- You can leave your car overnight. The ushers will be handing out complementary parking passes outside the church at the end of the ceremony
- If you are getting a taxi to the church, there will be transport available to take you to the reception
- The DJ will end at 01:00 AM and there will be an ongoing Silent Disco for those wishing to shake their tail feather for a little longer. You can of course leave any time, it's a very long day! Local taxi numbers are:
