Dear Members and Friends of Second Baptist Church:

Thank you to all who pivoted with us and attended/watched this past Sunday's service, which we put in place following the rain cancellation of the Blessing of the Animals (rescheduled to 9/5/21). There were 23 people who came to the live service, and 27 who have joined us online so far this week. For summer in New England in the pandemic, that's fair. The pre-made cups and bread for the First Sunday at First Baptist arrived yesterday, so we know we have that to look forward to in the near future.

As we continue to do things in person, please encourage your unvaccinated friends (who are medically capable of being vaccinated) to go do it! According to covidactnow.org, Connecticut's current full vaccination rate has creeped slightly upward to 62%. We have NOT reached researcher's minimum expectations for herd immunity, and the infection rate in Hartford County is now 1.2 (an additional 1 1/5 case from every confirmed case). When we reopened, it had fallen to around .7-.8, when meant that cases were shrinking. We need to maintain proactive behaviors to ensure we can continue to gather.
