

BUSINESS: President Kay Klass welcomed everyone in attendance and ascertained that a quorum was present. Kay declared the meeting open.

It is important to remember that the Association is not-for-profit, and while a loss of this nature may seem significant, the Management committee has invested this money in its members and for the benefit of the club

On a more positive note, the Association has made a savings on insurance, newsletter expenses in comparison to the 2020/21 fiscal year.

Finally, I would like to thank the Management Committee for their continued support and help over the past year, also thank you to Gary Fernandez for acting as Auditor for the Association.

The report was moved and seconded by Robert Harding and Marina Klassen.

2020-2021 AGM CATERING REPORT

As only two lunches were held during the past year there is nothing to report except to thank those who cooked and helped during the two lunches held. The proposed price increased discussed at last year's AGM was postponed until this year.

From Denis - during Christmas maybe gift a membership to a Family member as a Christmas gift.


From Roy – may organise an open day and give them a free lunch.

Just a few things to either remind you or know about the Sunday Lunches

- 1. Please remember that tables and seats cannot be reserved
- 2. Lunch Tickets cannot be bought for anyone who is not in attendance at the time of the purchase
- 3. You need to wait until the group of numbers that includes your ticket number is called before lining up for your meal
- 4. You can only buy one packet of cakes or dessert per person and you must line up yourself for the cakes, but if you are unable to line up to purchase cakes due a disability of some kind a special ticket will be issued so that a family member can buy them on your behalf, please see Carol to obtain the special ticket.
- 5. Please inform those Committee Members selling the lunch vouchers that you are over 80 or 90 to ensure you are charged correctly as we don't wish to offend anyone if we were to ask
- 6. If possible please bring the correct money to purchase your lunch or drinks as we don't carry a lot of change
- 7. Please have your Visitors sign the Visitors Book
- 8. Should anyone who is not over 80 or 90 be unable to line-up for their meal for one reason or another please see Carol Richards to make arrangements for the person's meal to be served to them.




