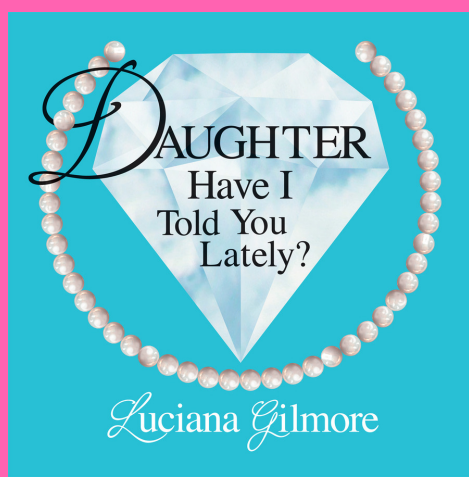
To date, Luciana and her daughters have created over 100 greeting cards on topics such as:
