1. Parent(s)/legal guardian(s) will pay all fees and tuition for the educational services provided by DEC to the student in accordance with the following provisions:

- c) In the event that DEC sustains any loss of or damage to property owned or leased by it as a result of the actions, conduct and/or fault of the student or the parent(s)/legal guardian(s), the parent(s)/legal guardian(s) shall be responsible for and immediately pay all costs or fees incurred in repairing or replacing the damaged property.
- d) **Attendance:** No refunds of tuition or fees will be granted for absences. If DEC cancels a session due to inclement weather, emergencies or other such situations, those missed sessions will be rescheduled.
- 2. **Supplies:** All students must bring the required supplies. A list of required supplies will be given at the time of registration.
- 3. Group Sessions: All sessions are group sessions.
- 4. DEC reserves the right to terminate this contract and/or dismiss the student from any of its programs if, at any time, DEC determines, in its sole discretion, that the conduct or cooperation of the student or parent(s)/legal guardian(s) is not in keeping with the Rules and Regulations of DEC. Parent(s)/legal guardian(s) acknowledge that they have received a copy of DEC's Rules and Regulations which was attached to this contract and is also available on DEC's website at www.DevillierEdu.com.
- 5. The parent(s)/legal guardian(s) agree that DEC is not the guardian or custodian of the student. The parent(s)/legal guardian(s) agree to protect, indemnify, defend and hold DEC harmless from any damages, claims, actions or causes of action occasioned through the actions or fault of the student.
- 6. Should either party to this contract fail to fulfill or breach the terms and obligations of this contract, the party aggrieved thereby shall have the right to initiate legal proceedings to enforce the terms of the contract. Venue for such legal proceedings shall be the 27th Judicial District Court in and for St. Landry Parish, Louisiana. In the event of such legal proceedings, the prevailing party shall be entitled to the recovery of reasonable attorney's fees and costs incurred in connection with said legal proceedings.
- 7. The parties hereto agree that the terms of this contract shall be construed in accordance with Louisiana law. In addition, they agree that the terms of this contract shall not be viewed or construed more favorably to the party who did not prepare the contract.

We, the parent(s)/legal guardian(s), agree that we have read the contents of this contract carefully and fully understand the contents thereof. Rules and Regulations
