SPORTS COLLECTIVE

In 2020 the Hikurangi Sports Collective started meeting to discuss key ideas for the future progress of Sport and Active Recreation in Hikurangi. Some attendees were representatives of sports clubs, some were just passionate locals. The agreed goal was that the group would like to pursue the formation of the 'Hikurangi Sports Hub.'



NEW WORKING PARTY

After back and forth discussion about a way forward, the group decided to have one last rally (held recently on the 3rd May) to get all of those interested around the table to help drive this project forward. After agreeing to a working 'Terms of Reference' (group rules) representatives in attendance signed up to be a part of the project working party.



WHERE TO NEXT?

The working party will meet again at the end of May. At this meeting a Chair & Secretary will be elected. From there the group will develop a project plan with the end goal being the build of a new Hikurangi Sports Hub facility. A key focus of the group is the establishment of a legal entity, these steps all take time and continued ongoing effort.

SPORTS HUB BUILDS & PLANS TAKE TIME

An example of the process the Hikurangi Sports Collective Working Party may take. For Hikurangi, the working party has been established. The next step is to develop a project plan and to identify the type of governance structure the group is likely to take. A working party like this one could take up 2 years to achieve their goals. A key part of their role is to engage a consultant to undertake a feasibility study. Members of the group are required to invest time, and to mahi consistently.
