



Raglan Day Parade

RULES OF ENTRY AND CODE OF CONDUCT.

The intention of the Fun Day and Parade is that the residents of Raglan and surrounding area should come together for fun and enjoy themselves in an environment of community spirit. Entrants are requested to participate in this spirit.

1. Raglan Festival will not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, article or vehicle
2. Any entrants likely to cause a breach of health and safety regulations, or failing to comply with these rules of entry, shall be denied entry or removed from The Parade
3. Any entrants likely to cause offence shall be denied entry or removed from The Parade
4. There shall be NO consumption of alcohol before or during The Parade by any participants
5. Any instruction given by a steward or authorised person must be obeyed immediately and in the case of any dispute, the decision of the Raglan Festival Chairman shall be final
6. All participants may relax if the Parade is stationary for more than 3 minutes
7. Lost persons (especially children) should report (or be presented) to a Steward and then to the Muster Point at the venue
8. All entrants shall report to the start point 45 minutes prior to the start
9. All entries must complete the entire route
10. Parade Floats are advised to carry a fire extinguisher and first aid kit. No smoking or fuel cans on floats
11. The driver of Parade Floats shall be responsible for the entire vehicle (including trailers and such like), and all participants thereon. He shall ensure that the entire vehicle is compliant with all relevant legislation and fully insured
12. There shall be no riding on Floats to (prior) or from (after) The Parade and participants shall only mount and alight Parade Floats whilst stationary using a sturdy ladder
13. No objects shall be thrown from Floats during the Parade
14. Participants to be seated while float is in motion. Maximum speed to be walking pace
15. Barriers to be erected on edge of float to prevent participants from falling off
16. All displays to be secure and checked by participants

Judging Categories:

- Best Presented Parade Float. - Most Humorous Parade Float.
- Best Presented Walking Group. - Most Humorous Walking Group.
- Best Presented Individual Walker - Most Humorous Individual Walker
