With the recently concluded refinancing – a measure the Vivonio Furniture Group takes

approximately every five to six years – two factors are guaranteed for the long-term success

of the company: On the one hand, the syndicated loan, which is provided by an international

consortium, permanently secures the company group through these still challenging

macroeconomic conditions. On the other, the once again increased framework of funding

allows Vivonio to invest in the further growth of its company group.

"We see that the European furniture industry has demonstrated a high degree of resilience

during the coronavirus pandemic – and at the same time has entered a new phase of

growth," says Niels Ackermann, Managing Director and CFO at Vivonio. "Since then, people

have been spending significantly more time at home overall, which has resulted in increased

demand for beautiful yet functional furnishings. We continue to see great growth potential

here in all areas of our business."

The successfully concluded refinancing confirms Vivonio's focus on growth. "As a group of

companies, we were able to convince the consortium with our high-quality portfolio within a

growing industry. We are now particularly well positioned to secure and expand our strong

position on the European furniture market in the future," says Niels Ackermann.
