Rules of the game





IMPORTANT TERMINOLOGY

ANTE

The first bet that all players place in order to be allowed to play.

BET/PLAY

The amount of money waged on a particular hand.

BLIND

The bet placed before the cards are dealt.

BOARD

The 'board' comprises five cards dealt face up in the centre of the table that any player around the table can use to build their poker hand

CHECK


Checking is when a player wants to stay in the game but doesn't want to place a bet. The player may call "check" once the first three community cards have been revealed, or when all of them have been revealed

COMMUNITY CARDS

Community cards are cards that are available for all players to build their poker hands.

FOLD

To pass; to leave the current game.



The table

HAND

The term 'hand' can be used in different ways:

- **1.** The top five cards used to build the winning hand.
- **2.** All cards that are dealt to a player to build his winning hand.

SUITS

Suits are hearts, clubs, diamonds and spades.

TRIPS

The Trips bonus is paid out as soon as a player's final 5-card hand contains three of a kind or even a better combination, regardless of whether he beats the bank or not.

HOW TO PLAY

Ultimate Texas Hold'EM® is an exciting poker game played against the bank using a combination of hole cards and community cards. It also offers the opportunity to place side bets (Trips). The aim of the game is to achieve the best possible combination of 5 cards out of a total of 7 (2 of your own + 5 community cards) and beat the bank.

Bonuses

- To raise or not to raise... You must make your final decision once all the community cards have been seen. However, you may also decide earlier on in the game.
- The earlier you make the decision, the higher the amount you can bet.
- The trips bonus is paid out as soon as you hold a 5-card hand containing three of a kind or better.

How to play

Once players have received their two cards, they can either check (stay in the game without placing a bet) or place a Play bet 3 or 4 times the amount of the Ante. The croupier then turns over the first three community cards. If you have not made a Play bet, you are given another chance to do so. You can choose to check again, or make a Play bet 2 times the amount of the Ante.



Finally, the croupier turns over the last two community cards. If you have not yet made a Play bet, you can either place the amount of the Ante on Play or pass. (In this case, you are no longer in the game and all your bets are collected. This is referred to as 'folding').

End of the game

The croupier turns over both of his cards and builds his hand. If you have a better hand, Play and Ante will be paid out at 1 to 1. If the croupier wins, the Ante, Play and Blind bets get paid into the bank. If the hand is a draw, all bets remain in place.

The Blind bet is paid out when your hand wins with a Straight or better.

If you win with less than a Straight, the Blind bet remains without being paid out. The Trips bonus is paid out when you have three of a kind or more in your hand.

Qualification of the croupier

In order to be able to play, the croupier needs to qualify with a pair. If he doesn't qualify, the ante is paid back to the players (a push). All other bets are treated as usual. The odds for Trips and Blind are printed on the game cloth.

PLAYING CARDS

Hand rankings

Royal Flush (highest Straight Flush)

$$\overset{A}{\bullet} + \overset{K}{\bullet} + \overset{Q}{\bullet} + \overset{J}{\bullet} + \overset{10}{\bullet}$$

Straight Flush (5 cards in a row from the same suit)

Four of a Kind (a set of 4 of the same-ranked cards)

$$K + K + K + K$$

Full House (3 of a kind and a pair)

Flush (5 cards from the same suit)

Straight (5 cards in a row)

Three of a Kind (a set of 3 of the same-ranked cards)
