Take a seat at the American roulette table and experience the American way of life!

ESSENTIALS OF THE GAME

The roulette table, or 'layout' is a table consisting of lines, numbers, words and symbols.

The main feature of the table is the roulette wheel, which is divided into 37 pockets, numbered 0 to 36. The numbers on the wheel are not arranged in number order and alternate between red and black pockets. The numbers on the table, however, are written in number order, 0 to 36.

The game is opened when the croupier calls "Place your bets please!", which is your signal to place your bets.

You are now able to place your chips on the desired fields on the table. The croupier will also be happy to place your bets on your behalf.

The roulette table

- The croupier spins the wheel in one direction and throws the ball onto the wheel in the other. Once "Rien ne vas plus!", "No more bets, please!" or "Keine Einsätze mehr!" has been announced, no more bets are allowed to be placed.
- As soon as the ball lands in a numbered field, the winning number and the winning colour are announced clearly.
- All the winnings for bets placed on this particular number are paid out. The winning number is marked with a dolly so that the croupier can proceed with payouts. The next game can then begin.

ODDS ARE 35 TO

SPLIT

ODDS ARE 17 TO 1







Two numbers that are vertically or horizontally adjacent to one another, e.g. 31 and 32, or 31 and 34.

STREET

ODDS ARE 11 TO 1





Three consecutive numbers in a horizontal lineon the table, e.g. 22, 23 and 24, or 0, 1 and 2.

CORNER

ODDS ARE 8 TO 1



Four numbers that form a square on the table e.g. 8, 9, 11 and 12.
The first four numbers – 0, 1, 2 and 3 – are known as the quatre premier/first four.

SIX LINE

ODDS ARE 5 TO 1



You play with 5 chips on 8 numbers that are divided between two slices of the wheel

You play with 5 chips on 5 numbers that are adjacent to one another on the wheel.

FINAL DIGITS - WITH 3 OR 4 CHIPS

You bet with 3 or 4 chips on the final digit of numbers from a specific series.

Numbers with the same final digit from a specific number series, e.g. final 3 = 3, 13, 23, 33 or final 7 = 7, 17, 27.

The winnings or payouts are always proportional to your risk.



BETS

As a rule, gamblers place their bets themselves. However, the croupier will be happy to place bets on your behalf if he has time to do so during the game. You may place your bets in the form of coloured chips, with your own dedicated colour. These coloured chips have no actual value and gamblers only use them to place their bets on the roulette table. Each player decides how much their coloured chips are 'worth', and this amount is clearly marked for everybody round the table.

Because a player's coloured chips have no monetary face value, they can only be used for gambling at the roulette table.

Of course, you may also use standard chips to play American Roulette. We kindly request that you exchange your coloured chips for standard chips as soon as you have finished gambling and before leaving the table. The minimum bet is displayed at each table.



GENERAL INFORMATION

The Casino's experienced staff are responsible for ensuring that players observe the current rules of play. If you have any queries, please do not hesitate to ask the Duty Manager.



We continually strive to make sure that your evening is a memorable occasion and your visit is as enjoyable as possible.

It is an international custom to leave a small part of your winnings – as much as you feel is appropriate – for the casino staff.
