- 1. 3 Leagues of 10-10-10
- 2. All fixtures to be Home and Away
- 3. Promotion and Relegation to be "One Up; One Down" after first year, with 10th in NHL Div Two to be automatically relegated to Regionals.
- 4. By 2000/2001, all NHL Prem games to be on water-based pitches
- 5. Matches to be in two blocks, with season from September to May, with mid-season break December to January
- 6. Champions League to be played between top 3 NHL Prem and HA Cup winners (or top 4 in NHL Prem) and at Milton Keynes. Will govern Euro participation
- 7. Each NHL Prem to play one home game at Milton Keynes, thus giving 2 appearances at MK for each team, per season
- 8. Play Offs to be over May Bank Holiday Weekend. Pool Games to be Friday, Saturday and Sunday with a Cross-Over on Monday; NB Four games in 4 days
- 9. New Placings to turn on NHL League positions at end of 1998/9 season (ie next year)

NHL PREMIER

1st - 9th in NHL Prem

10th spot between 10th in NHL Prem and NHL Div One Champions (in Cross-Over Match)

NHL ONE

11th & 12th in NHL Prem

Loser of 10th NHL Prem v NHL ONE Champs (see above)

2nd - 8th in NHL One

NHL TWO

9th - 16th in NHL One [8 teams]

2 from Play Offs

2 pools of 4 teams, ie 17th, 18th & 19th in NHL One, plus 5 Regionals. Pool Winners and Pool Runners Up play Cross-Overs to find 2 for NHL Two

SUMMARY

On this basis, we need to finish 8th or better in Div One next year and to get hold of a water-based pitch, if we want to get on
