The 1st XI were drawn in the same group as Tulse Hill and Chichester (the other group held Oxford Hawks, Trojans and Sunbury).

The first game against Tulse Hill ended in a 2-0 loss for Hampstead. The half time score of 0-0 was looking likely to be the end result until Tulse Hill scored twice in the last 15 minutes. It seemed a harsh result given the amount of Hampstead possession and dominance but the difference remained that Tulse Hill capitalised on their chances.

Hampstead then had to beat Chichester to secure second position in the group and a semi-final place. Hampstead eased the pressure on themselves by scoring early in the first half through left wing Barbara Gardner. Goals from Lis Steele (from a penalty corner set-play) and two from Jo Edmondson in the second half put the game beyond doubt.

Tulse Hill won the group and went through to the semi-final to play Trojans.

Hampstead's semi-final match against Oxford Hawks was a tense match with Hampstead unable to maintain the form from the Saturday's group game against Chichester. Hampstead's defence was under continual pressure from Hawk's fast wings and forwards with the nearest chance of the game falling to Hawks with a well hit shot from the top of the dee which hit the far post. 0-0 at full time and with no extra time it went to strokes.

Hampstead's stroke takers were Liz Charnell, Katherine Stubbs, Jane Thompson, Laura Davies and Karen Pullar. Hampstead converted their first four strokes and with goalie Leanne Rogers saving two Hawk's strokes, the game was won 4-2 on strokes.

Trojans won their game against Tulse Hill and were also promoted to the South League for the 1994/95 season.
