EASTER

As you may know, after our dis-appointing efforts over Weston-super-Mare during the last couple of seasons, we have agreed that no 'pukka' Easter Festival entry should be submitted again until spontaneous demand from the members of the upper XI's is sufficient to guarantee its success. Nevertheless, we have had an invitation from Wolfgang Schues (who returned to Germany in November) to send a 'social' side to a festival in Hamburg at Easter and Berry Bermingham has agreed to work out the possibilities and make arrangements if support is sufficient. A provisional estimate is that the minimum fare and hotel cost would be of the order of £29 (travelling overnight by boat and then train). Anybody who is really interested at this sort of cost, and who is prepared to guarantee not to drop out once they have given a firm 'yes', is asked to get in touch with Berry during the next two weeks and then a decision will be made on whether to go ahead or not.

Having said that, I should also point out, for those of you who will be in London over Easter, that (after last year's improved performance) we have been invited to the N.P.L. Festival at Teddington again. Alan Kurtz has agreed to organise this entry again and, nearer the time, I shall put an 'availability' slip on the bulletin. In the mean-time, anybody who would like to get his name down for a game at Teddington should get in touch with Alan, stating availability for Friday, Saturday or Monday. And we would like a reasonable cross-section of all XI's for this entry, as last year.
