The ground should be good and changing accommodation, teas and the bar are all first class.

Progress has been made in getting together a modest fixture list for the first season and some twelve fixtures in addition to practice games have so far been arranged, but much spade work remains.

Now equipment and general running expenses will eat far into our small capital. At the same time we feel it is essential to preserve the entire independence of the Hampstead H.O. until such time as we can, with easy minds, make over the funds to a permanent body both willing and capable of assuring the lasting future of our ancient Club.
