ALTERNATIVE PITCHES

Major drainage work will be carried out at the club this season, therefore the following pitches will be extensively used.

WILL ALL PLAYERS (Hampstead and opposition) PLEASE BRING BOTH SETS OF FOOTWEAR.

The Match Secretary will be in contact with his counterpart from other clubs in the week preceding matches to notify him of pitches to be used (in bad weather venues are likely to be changed late).

CORAM'S FIELDS: Guilford Street (off Grays Inn Road, W.C.1.

This is an Avon Rubber Surface pitch and no studded footwear is permitted (this includes goalkeepers and umpires). Teams go direct to ground where there are changing facilities.

CREIGHTON NORTH SCHOOL (two shale pitches): Creighton Avenue, Muswell Hill, N.10 (ten minutes from the club).

Opponents should come to the club first where they will be escorted to the ground.

HIGHGATE WOOD SCHOOL (one shale pitch): Adjoining the Hornsey Ground, changing at the clubhouse.

On shale pitches flat shoes must be worn (excluding goalkeepers).

Subscriptions are due on 1st October, or upon election. **There is a surcharge of £3 if payment of subscription is not made within one month of due date.**

A "match fee" is also levied after each game played.

All new members of the Hockey Club must pay an admission fee of £20 to the Hornsey Club which is a loan repayable on demand when leaving the Club. This loan is waived for Students and members under 21.

EQUIPMENT

All members should play in the correct club colours, which are available from 'Sportcenta,' 15 Park Road, Crouch End, N.8. (01-348 6151)—two minutes walk from the Club.

A white shirt and flat rubber-soled footwear should be carried at ALL games in case the shale pitch is used.

TEAM SELECTION

Notices are posted on Tuesday of each week. If no notice has arrived by Friday, members should telephone the Team Secretary, or their usual Team Captain, to check on their selection.

Reserves should keep themselves free to play until the morning of the match.

Members (including reserves) should notify their Team Captain IMMEDIATELY if there is any doubt about their availability for the following weekend. The Selection Committee has the right to refuse to select any member who cancels less than two days before a game.

CANCELLATION DUE TO WEATHER

MEMBERS:

It is the RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH PLAYER to telephone 584 1001 (the Answering Service) after 11.30 a.m. on the morning of the match to find out if it is still to be played. Members are advised to telephone whether or not there is any doubt about the state of grounds because Answerings is sometimes used to communicate a change of venue.

OPPONENTS:

Would opponents please note that late cancellations and liaison on ground conditions will normally be handled by the Match Secretary at the Hornsey Club number 340 5546 on Saturday mornings between 10.30 a.m. and 11 a.m. or at his home number 263 0753.

The Spaniards Manager will normally handle late cancellations for Sunday Spaniards matches.

PUNCTUALITY

Out of politeness to opponents and umpires members must be changed and READY TO PLAY at the notified time (generally 2.15 p.m. from November to January; 2.45 p.m. in other months). If held up or lost a member should telephone the ground and notify the Team Captain.
