TRAVELLING DIRECTIONS

By Public Transport: Piccadilly Line to Finsbury Park — W7 bus to Wolseley Road (just after Crouch End Broadway, on left-hand side) — along Wolseley Road, turn first right into Tivoli Road — Ground ahead.

By Car: A1 to Highgate Underground Station — East into Shepherd's Hill then to Wolseley Road — about 1 mile along at bottom of hill, turn left into Tivoli Road — Ground straight ahead.

1. (NR) NEW RIVER SPORT CENTRE, WHITE HART LANE, N22. (N.B. If Tottenham Hotspur are playing at home, approach from Wood Green).

2. (MR) MARKET ROAD CENTRE, MARKET ROAD, N7.

3. (PD) PADDINGTON RECREATION GROUND, CARLTON VALE, MAIDA VALE, W9.

4. (PS) PARKSIDE SPORTS CENTRE, PARKSIDE (off Dollis Hill Lane), NW2.

These are all "Astroturf" type pitches and NO STUDED footwear is permitted, including umpires and goal-keepers. Teams go direct to the grounds.

5. (HW) HIGHGATE WOOD SCHOOL

This is a shale pitch next to main ground. Change at Club. NO STUDS.

6. (CS) CREIGHTON NORTH SCHOOL, CREIGHTON AVENUE, MUSWELL HILL, N10.

Teams go direct to ground. Shale pitch — NO STUDS.
