HAMPSTEAD HOCKEY CLUB

Minutes of a Meeting of the Hockey Club Sub-Committee  
held on Saturday, 13th January, 1951.

Present:-

Messrs. R. L. Milsted (Chairman); I. Eiloart, W. Fletcher,  
H. Leedham-Green (Chairman of the Cricket Club), R.H. Matthews,  
A. Reed, J. C. Sankey and S. J. Saunders, & G.P. Walker.

1. Selection of Teams

The procedure for team selection was discussed.

Resolved: That the Sub-Committee meet at the Surrey Tavern,  
Surrey Street, on each Monday during the hockey season or at such other  
rendezvous as may be found convenient for the purpose of selecting  
teams, the first meeting to be held on Monday, 22nd January, at 6.15 p.m.

2. A letter from the Secretary of the Hendon Hockey Club enquiring whether  
the Club would care to enter a team for the Six-a-Side Tournament which Hendon  
are to hold on Saturday, 11th March, 1951, was read.

Resolved: The Hendon Hockey Club be informed that it is regretted  
that Hampstead are unable to accept on account of its own fixture commitments.

3. A letter from the Cambridge Town Hockey Club requesting a fixture for next  
season was read.

Resolved: The Match Secretary be authorised to arrange a fixture  
preferably on 23rd February, 1952.

4. It was reported that the Hockey Association "Circus" had enquired whether  
the Club would be interested in a lecture being arranged on general hockey  
matters.

Resolved: Mr. R.L. Milsted be requested to explain to the Manager  
that it would be impracticable this season.

5. Fixtures

Mr. Milstead explained the difficulties that are being experienced in  
arranging matches with the Club's old opponents and suggested that it might be  
possible to arrange a meeting with the relevant match secretaries of the various  
Clubs to explore the possibility of regaining these fixtures.

Resolved: That the meeting be organised and take place at  
Mr. Fletcher's house on an agreed date.

6. School Matches

It was agreed in principle that some mid-week games against schools should  
be played, and that the matter should be pursued further.

7. Easter Festivals

It was agreed in principle that the Club should send a side to an Easter  
Hockey Festival in future years. It was agreed that this was impracticable  
this year, but that the matter should be ventilated at the general meeting of  
the Hockey Section.
