DIRECTIONS TO GROUND

BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT: Piccadilly Line to Finsbury Park. Thence W7 bus to Wolsley Road (just after Crouch End Broadway, on left-hand side). Along Wolsley Road, turn first right into Tivoli Road. Ground straight ahead.

BY CAR: A1 to Highgate Underground Station. East into Shepherd's Hill then Wolsley Road. About 1 mile along, at the bottom of the hill, turn left into Tivoli Road. Ground straight ahead.

ALTERNATIVE PITCHES

The Club also has the use of two *shale* pitches during ground improvement at Hornsey.

The first is at Highgate Wood School, immediately adjoining the Hornsey ground. Players should change at the Clubhouse and walk through the gate at the bottom corner of the ground.

The second is at Creighton North School, Creighton Avenue, Muswell Hill, N.10.

BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT: W7 bus, past the end of Wolsley Road to Muswell Hill. Along Queens Avenue, turn second right along Tetherdown, then third left along Creighton Avenue. School on left.

OR: Northern Line to East Finchley. Thence 102 bus along Fortis Green to Tetherdown (fourth on left). Then as above.

BY CAR: Park Road/A504 to Muswell Hill or A1/A1000 to East Finchley. Then as above.

Please note which games are being played on these pitches and carry flat rubber-soled shoes (except for goalkeepers).

SUBSCRIPTIONS

Vacation, country members and other "occasional" playing members, may also be admitted at reduced rates, as may local schoolboys.

Subscriptions are due on 1st October, or upon election. There is a surcharge of £3 if payment of subscription is not made within one month of due date.

A "match fee" is also levied after each game played.

EQUIPMENT

All members should play in the correct club colours, which are available from the Equipment Officer. A white shirt should also be carried to all games.

Flat rubber-soled footwear should be carried to all home games in case the shale pitch is used.

Club ties are available from the Equipment Officer at the clubhouse.

TEAM SELECTION

Notices are posted on Tuesday of each week. If no notice has arrived by Friday, members should telephone the Team Secretary, or their usual Team Captain, to check on their selection.

Reserves should keep themselves free to play until the morning of the match.

Members (including reserves) should notify their Team Captain IMMEDIATELY if there is any doubt about their availability for the following week-end. Captains have the right to refuse to select any member who cancels less than two days before a game.

CANCELLATION DUE TO WEATHER

MEMBERS:

It is the RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH PLAYER to telephone 584 1001 (the Answering Service) after 11.30 a.m. on the morning of the match to find out if it is still to be played. Members are advised to telephone if there is ANY DOUBT AT ALL about the state of grounds because Answerings is sometimes used to communicate a change of venue.

OPPONENTS:

Would opponents please note that late cancellations and liaison on ground conditions will normally be handled by the Match Secretary at the Hornsey Club number 340 5546 on Saturday mornings between 10.30 a.m. and 11.00 a.m., or at his home number 435 6503.

The Spaniards Manager will normally handle late cancellations for Sunday matches.

PUNCTUALITY

Out of politeness to opponents and umpires members must be changed and READY TO PLAY at the notified time (generally 2.15 p.m. from November to January; 2.45 p.m. in other months). If held up or lost a member should telephone the ground and notify his Team Captain.
