Performance of the day came from Andy Cook of Ipswich who scored 5 goals, all in open play, as Ipswich beat Romford by 6-1.

Jersey, who so often grab Cup Headlines in the early stages, are on the way again. They entertained United Services Plymouth and won 2-0 but must now travel to the mainland to play West Wilts in the second round.

The 36 national league clubs join the Royal Bank of Scotland Cup in the third round and so the outcome of these second round ties will be eagerly awaited as will the third round draw.
