
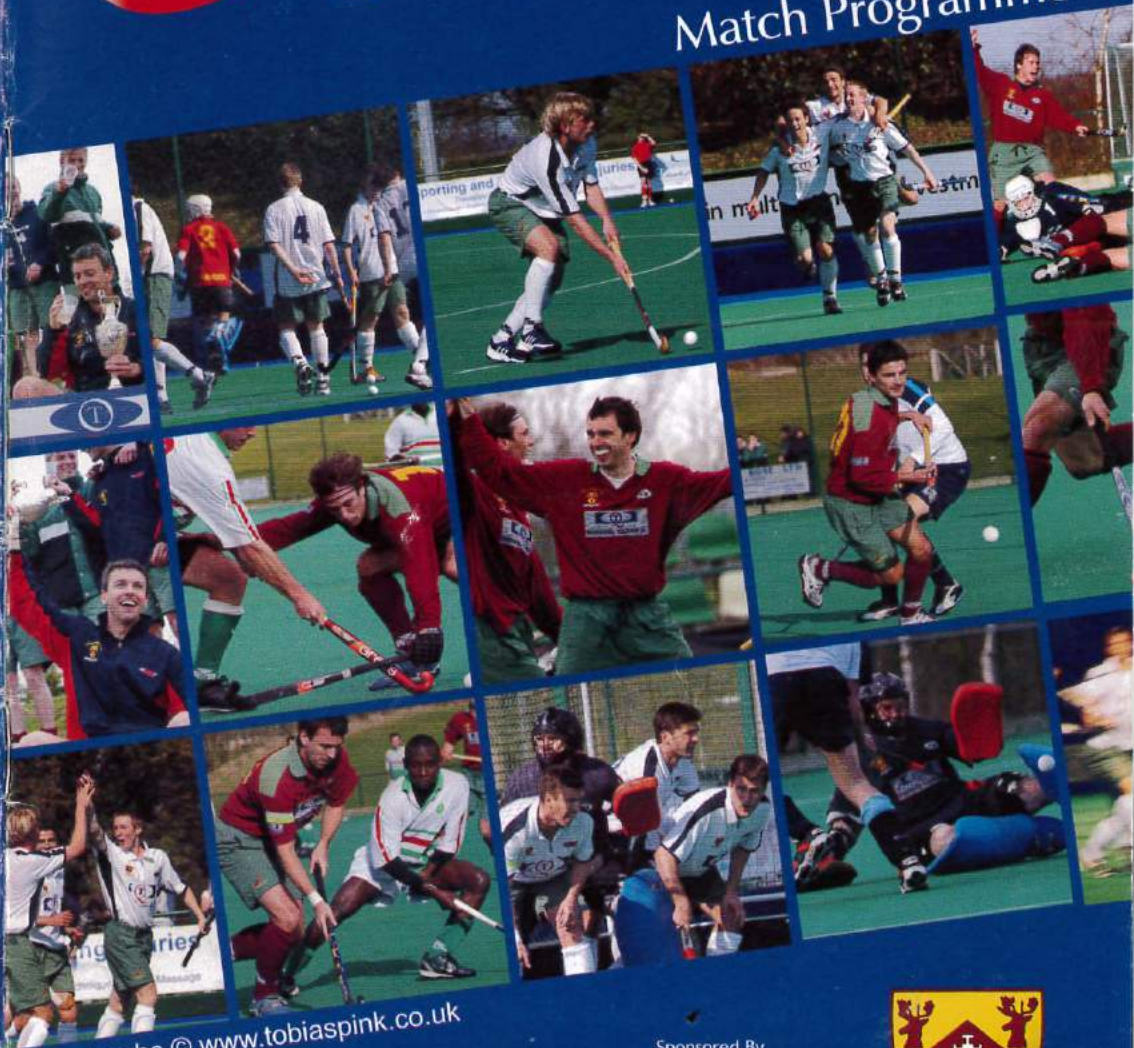

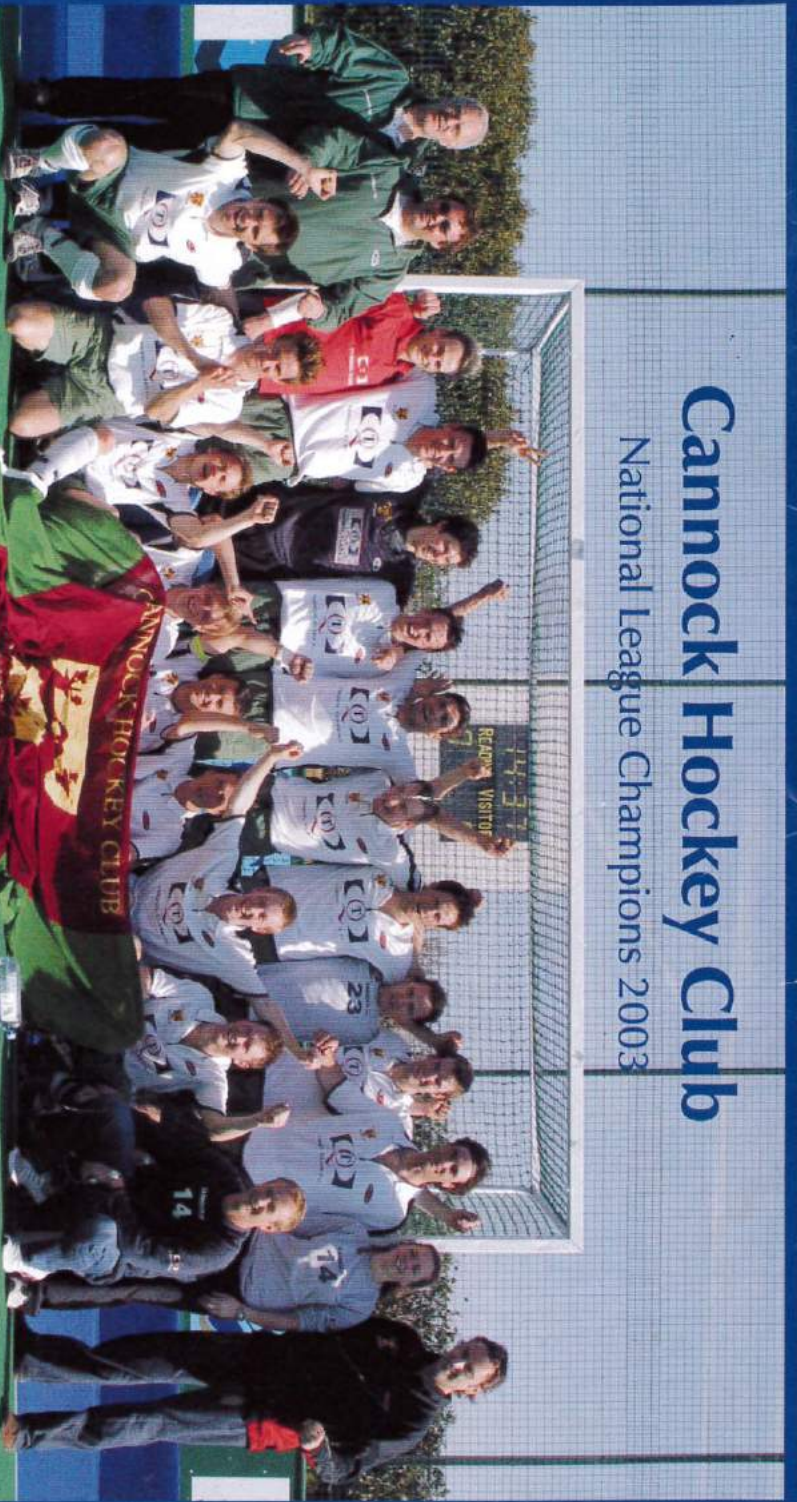

HAMPSTEAD CONTINUE WINNING START

Hampstead continued their 100% start to the season with a 2-1 win at Guildford in the Men's Premier Division. This means that they are two points ahead of Cannock who also won 3-0 at Loughborough. Andy Brogdon scored twice for the visitors who could enjoy the luxury of a missed Simon Ramsden stroke against a side who beat them twice in competitive matches last season. Reading are third with six points following their 4-0 win over St Albans. Canterbury are level on points after winning by the same score line at Teddington. Surbiton who are also on six points were made to work much harder for their win with a Bill Waugh goal enough to secure the points at Old Loughtonians.

The only two sides with two wins out of two in Men's Division One met on Sunday and it was Firebrands who proved victorious beating Bournville 2-1 thanks to two goals from Tim Barralet-Leak. Bowdon go second after an amazing 8-1 win over Beeston, Stephen Brogdon emulating his brother Andy at Cannock with two goals. This leaves Beeston bottom when many would have predicted them to be in the top two. Nottingham had a good 4-3 home win over Doncaster despite a hat-trick for the visitors Duncan Parnis and Chelmsford defeated Stourport 5-1. Belper won 2-1 at Southgate who, along with Beeston have yet to pick up any points.

East Grinstead's 100% start to the Men's Division Two campaign was halted at Havant in an exciting 5-5 draw. EG led 5-3 with seven minutes to go but Andy Lloyd capped a fine comeback with a 70th minute equaliser. Old Georgians go to within a point of the top after they won 5-3 at Lewes with James Tindall scoring four times. Formby are up to third thanks to a 2-1 win in the North West derby at Brooklands MU. Indian Gymkhana came out top of their local battle with Hounslow & Ealing winning 4-2 and Barford Tigers won for the first time this season, 3-2 at Oxford Hawks. This result leaves Hawks bottom of the table as Leek picked up their first EHL point in a 1-1 draw at Bath Buccaneers.

2nd XI CUP

Clubs have been asked if they wish to participate in a knockout competition for EHL 2nd XIs. Ties will be drawn taking into account geographic location but to avoid, if possible, teams meeting each other who would do so in existing league structures. Standard England Hockey KO cup regulations will be used. Player eligibility regulations will be finalised but there is an onus on clubs who participate to recognise why this tournament is being introduced when selecting sides! It is anticipated using the number of times players have started in / played in EHL games as a means of defining who is eligible to play to prevent 1st XI regulars from participating.
