### DIRECTIONS TO GROUND

By PUBLIC TRANSPORT: Piccadilly Line to Finsbury Park. Thence W7 bus to Wolseley Road (just after Crouch End Broadway, on left-hand side). Along Wolseley Road, turn first right into Tivoli Road. Ground straight ahead.

By CAR: A1 to Highgate Underground Station. East into Shepherd's Hill then Wolseley Road. About 1 mile along at the bottom of the hill, turn left into Tivoli Road. Ground straight ahead.

### ALTERNATIVE PITCHES

The Club has the use of three *shale* pitches.

The first is at Highgate Wood School, immediately adjoining the Hornsey ground.

The second is at Creighton North School, Creighton Avenue, Muswell Hill, N10 (10 minutes from the club).

The third is at the Hornsey School for Girls, Inderwick Road, N8 (five minutes from the club).

Opponents should come to the club first where they will be escorted to the venue of their match.

*Major drainage work will be carried out at the club this season, therefore these shale pitches will be extensively used. All players (including opponents) must bring flat shoes (except for goalkeepers).*

Vacation, country members and other "occasional" playing members, may also be admitted at reduced rates, as may local schoolboys.

Subscriptions are due on 1st October, or upon election. **There is a surcharge of £3 if payment of subscription is not made within one month of due date.**

A "match fee" is also levied after each game played.

All new members of the Hockey Club must pay an admission fee of £11 to the Hornsey Club of which £10 is a loan repayable on demand when leaving the Club. This loan is waived for Students and members under 21.

### EQUIPMENT

All members should play in the correct club colours, which are available from 'Sportcenta,' 15 Park Road, Crouch End, N.8. (01-348 6151)—two minutes walk from the Club.

A white shirt and flat rubber-soled footwear should be carried at ALL games in case the shale pitch is used.

### TEAM SELECTION

Notices are posted on Tuesday of each week. If no notice has arrived by Friday, members should telephone the Team Secretary, or their usual Team Captain, to check on their selection.

Reserves should keep themselves free to play until the morning of the match.

Members (including reserves) should notify their Team Captain IMMEDIATELY if there is any doubt about their availability for the following weekend. The Selection Committee has the right to refuse to select any member who cancels less than two days before a game.

## CANCELLATION DUE TO WEATHER

### MEMBERS:

It is the RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH PLAYER to telephone 584 1001 (the Answering Service) after 11.30 a.m. on the morning of the match to find out if it is still to be played. Members are advised to telephone whether or not there is any doubt about the state of grounds because Answerings is sometimes used to communicate a change of venue.

### OPponents:

Would opponents please note that late cancellations and liaison on ground conditions will normally be handled by the Match Secretary at the Hornsey Club number 340 5546 on Saturday mornings between 10.30 a.m. and 11 a.m. or at his home number 722-2728.

The Spaniards Manager will normally handle late cancellations for Sunday Spaniards matches.

### PUNCTUALITY

Out of politeness to opponents and umpires members must be changed and READY TO PLAY at the notified time (generally 2.15 p.m. from November to January; 2.45 p.m. in other months). If held up or lost a member should telephone the ground and notify the Team Captain.
