May I remind you again that we could possibly get into the Thanet Festival this year if there is enough interest. It is always played during the 3rd week-end in April, so it doesn't clash with other festivals, nor with visits to see the family etc., at Easter. And it only lasts for Saturday and Sunday (though they are two action-packed days, including four games of hockey and a festival dance), so only two cheap nights in a hotel are necessary - or even one if you don't mind driving from London early on the Saturday morning. It would be a good thing for us to be represented at a festival so please let me know - either by phone or on the tear-off slip if you prefer - if you would be interested in going. Within the next week please.

I have forgotten to mention, so far, that the London League was, in the event, revised before the season began. There is now just one division consisting of the 20 or so teams in the league. Games against all these clubs count towards the league (3 points for a win and 1 for a draw) and positions will be judged on percentages of points gained at the end of the season - so it won't be necessary to re-arrange cancelled matches. The top four teams will then go into semi-finals to decide the league champions (though I don't honestly think that will concern us this season).

The Club ties which we lost three or four years ago have turned up and will be on sale behind the bar at the Supper this week (15/- each). By the way, the Supper will, of course, go ahead even if the games at Hornsey are cancelled this week.
