Helping People Turn Their Lives Around

The Crossroads Center is a non-profit community agency which specializes in helping people who suffer from addictions and mental health issues.

We provide culturally appropriate addiction and mental health services to individuals and their families. The agency is licensed by the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services and is accredited by the Joint Commission and Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF).

The Crossroads Center offers many different behavioral health programs to serve adults, adolescents and the entire family:

- Adult and Adolescent Outpatient Programs
- Medication Assisted Treatment Program
- Addiction Prevention Program
- Chaney Allen Women's Perinatal / Postpartum Program
- Adult Residential Care (ARC) Program
- Gambling Addiction Program

STOP Program

Substance Abuse Treatment Outpatient Program (STOP) is designed to assist individuals who can utilize an outpatient environment as a mode of intervention for the illness of substance dependence and as a means of maintaining sobriety once the illness has been arrested. It provides services primarily to adults referred through the criminal justice system. However, individuals referred through other sources are also seen within this program. This program recognizes the importance of collaboration between the treatment system and the criminal justice system and encourages a team approach in the management and support of client's cases. It can provide primary care in the treatment of substance abuse / dependence or provide follow up maintenance of sobriety for those moving further into their recovery.

SAMI Program

The Substance Abuse Mental Illness (SAMI) program provides comprehensive outpatient recovery services to adults suffering with substance abuse and mental illness. Persons with co-occurring disorders of mental illness and substance dependence receive treatment for each of these disorders simultaneously. The program utilizes individualized treatment design to structure optimal therapeutic outcomes and recoveries for both primary diseases.

Adolescent Outpatient Program

The Crossroads Center Adolescent Outpatient program is designed to provide community based treatment to youth and their families. The program uses a community based approach, providing treatment in the home, school or at the agency, which is less restrictive than an institutional approach and more family centered. Parental and family involvement is encouraged under this model.

Our program provides full treatment for individuals ages 12-18 who are suffering from alcohol and drug-related problems and mental health problems.

Chaney Allen Women's Services Program

The Crossroads Center's Chaney Allen Women's Continuum of Care program is designed to provide structured, progressive treatment to substance abusing women within the State of Ohio. This program has an emphasis on treating women with dependent children and women of childbearing age, women who are pregnant or have given birth, experienced a miscarriage or had an abortion within 12 months preceding admission.

Adult Residential Center (ARC)

This program is a co-ed program for clients who live in Hamilton County. It is composed of Mental Health Court, CHANGE Court, Short-Term Rehab and/or In-tensive Outpatient.

Gambling Addiction Program

Gambling is risking something of value on an event that is determined mostly by chance. For most people, gambling is a form of recreation. For some, however, the pleasure has spiraled out of control. We offer treatment to individuals affected by this problem, through individualized counseling or groups.

Medication Assisted Treatment Program

The Crossroads Medication Assisted Treatment Program is licensed by the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services to administer and dispense narcotic medications for either ambulatory detoxification treatment, residential, outpatient or maintenance therapy to persons who have become addicted to narcotics/opiates. The program, also provides a comprehensive range of psychiatric and rehabilitative services as needed. It is certified by the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF).

Addiction Prevention Program

We provide evidence based educational programming to raise awareness about substance misuse and its impact on youth, adults, families and communities. This helps participants make better decisions and use new problem solving strategies regarding alcohol, drugs and tobacco use.
